FY22 Community Innovation and Outreach (CIAO) Cooperative Agreement

The Food Nutrition Service (FNS) administers the nutrition assistance programs of the US Department of Agriculture. FNS works to promote nutrition security through the administration of fifteen federal nutrition assistance programs, including the special supplemental nutrition program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC). FNS anticipates awarding up to \$20 million to a grantee to ultimately test the effectiveness of community outreach strategies in increasing WIC participation, especially among underserved populations within a community. This announcement of funding is for a one-time cooperative agreement with an accredited institution of higher education, nonprofit research entity, or other nonprofit organization.
