## *What are the benefits of the TN Master Small Ruminant Producer program?*

- Participation in educational sessions with specialists that provide opportunities to gain knowledge in small ruminant production and marketing.
- Informative interaction with other producers.
- An opportunity to identify all the facets of small ruminant management and production for a new, novice, or experienced producer.
- TN Master Small Ruminant Producer Certification to qualify for the Tennessee Agriculture Enhancement Program (TAEP) through Tennessee Department of Agriculture (TDA).

## **Registration Fee:**

- **\$100** for one producer– includes one certification, one FAMANCHA, and one notebook.
- **\$125** for one producer plus one (spouse/child/guest) - includes one certification, one FAMACHA, and one notebook. Second person will not receive any certifications or notebook but may participate in meals and activities.
- **\$200** for couple includes two certificates, two FAMANCHA's and two notebooks. This would be for those needing two certificates for TAEP.
